Planned Parenthood: A short history

During World War Two our nation sent troops to Europe to fight against Hitler and the Nazi ideologies which included creating a supreme race of Aryans. The Nazis would force abortions and sterilization upon women who were either non-Aryan or those who were mentally challenged or suspected of having "inferior genes". While we would like to think that this was an isolated incident, this unfortunately is not the case.

American born Margaret Sanger devoted her entire life to promoting birth control and she believed that the purpose of birth control was "to create a race of thoroughbreds". On people of color, immigrants, and the needy she believed that they were "human weeds, reckless breeders, and spawning human beings who never should have been born". It was her full intention to exterminate the entire African American population as well as all those who are mentally or physically handicapped through birth control and sterilization. She also believed that parents should be required to submit applications to have children and that those who were deemed unfit should be encouraged to become sterilized and rewarded if they did so. It is from these Nazi type views that Planned Parenthood was created.

Planned Parenthood was officially established in 1942 after its named was changed from the American Birth Control League and its clinics date back to as early as 1916 when Margret Sanger founded the first clinic in Brooklyn New York. To date Planned Parenthood has slaughtered over 4 million preborn babies all in the name of reproductive rights. Planned Parenthood claims that performing abortions accounts for only 3% of the services they perform, however this does not consider that many of these services are given to the same person, so the abortion rate per person is way higher. Currently 1 in every 4 abortions in the United States is committed by Planned Parenthood and 33.4% of all African American pregnancies result in abortion compared to that of 14.3% of Caucasian pregnancies. While it is hard to know how many disabled or mentally challenged babies have been aborted up to an estimated 92% of parents who are notified that their child has a disability choose to abort their child under high pressure and influence from doctors. Unfortunately Margaret Sanger's hopes are being fulfilled. While Planned Parenthood has tried to distance themselves from their founder, saying that her views are outdated and no longer reflect the organization the facts

speak for themselves and clearly suggest otherwise.

Recently several videos have surfaced on the internet showing Planned Parenthood selling body parts of aborted babies. Planned Parenthood claims that the videos are doctored and falsified, however these videos clearly show the unethical behaviour of Planned Parenthood.

That being said, according to a Federal Law in the United States that was enacted by a "pro-abortion former Congressman Henry Waxman, who was one of Planned Parenthood's top lieutenants while he served in Congress;" the law allows for "reasonable payments associated with the transportation, implantation, processing, preservation, quality control, or storage of human fetal tissue." As a result "this, the law merely "prohibits" selling fetal tissue in a definition that is so narrow that the exposed Planned Parenthood practices" will most likely allow their heavily paid lawyers and attorneys to protect them until a proper law is enacted.


While these accusations and facts are American based there is no reason to believe that Planned Parenthood in Canada acts any differently. Founded under the views of Margaret Sanger and extremely similar to that of Nazi Germany, Planned Parenthood is an organization that <u>does not look out for women's health</u> but rather in favor of its own interests, ideologies, and profitability. As informed individuals within the Prolife movement it is our job to pressure our politicians to enact laws that are just and reflect human life from the moment of conception to that of natural death.
